1. There is a large percentage of Muslims in the school, while there is a small increase in the number of Christians and Hindus, and a decline in the number of Sikhs
2. Parental and governor requests for collective worship to be in accordance with the needs and backgrounds of the pupils.

5. Briefly outline the frequency and character of the alternative acts of collective worship which will take place following a renewal.

1. Collective worship to take place on a daily basis.
2. All pupils will be invited to take part in the daily act of collective worship in their own way with the opportunity to reflect accordingly.
3. Pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development and confidence will be enhanced by assembly themes which draw upon materials and resources relevant to the main community religion and culture as well as aspect from other religions.
4. All the major festivals will be celebrated as part of collective worship at the appropriate times

6. How will leadership of these alternative acts of worship be monitored?

1. All staff will participate in, and share in, leading the alternative acts of collective worship. (Many members of staff follow community religions and will contribute and share their knowledge and expertise). Outside speakers will be encouraged to lead collective worship if appropriate.
2. A theme will be decided for each half term or appropriate length of time..
3. The collective worship co-ordinator be responsible for the policy and arrangements for the delivery rota, and monitoring of collective worship.
4. All staff and governors will be involved in a review of collective worship on a termly basis.
